Content	<p>Trainer</p> <p>In recent years, ELT materials have included a focus on skills other than the traditional four (reading, listening, writing & speaking). These further skills include ones such as study skills and digital skills. Cambridge has introduced a suite of competencies it calls the <i>Cambridge Life Competencies Framework</i>, or <i>CLC</i> for short.</p> <p>This workshop offers an overview of the several components of the <i>CLC</i> and to take a look at some of the resources in more depth: <i>Thinking and Learning</i> comprises Creative Thinking, Critical Thinking, Learning to Learn, and Digital Literacy, while <i>Social Skills</i> comprises Communication, Collaboration, Emotional Development, and Social Responsibilities. Participants are encouraged to discuss both approaches and potential activities for application in the context of their own teaching situations.</p>
